Don Bridge Memorial Scholarship

General Information

Objective:

Provide scholarship assistance to individuals pursuing a degree in the performing arts at a college or university. Award amounts, typically between \$500-2,000, are dependent upon funds raised and number of awards bestowed. The award is contingent upon acceptance and attendance at your institution. Payment will be made only to the institution.

Who is Eligible:

Any Dare, Currituck, or Hyde County graduating senior planning, as well as previous recipients who continue, to pursue a degree in the performing arts. Participation in Theatre of Dare productions is not a prerequisite for consideration.

How to Apply:

Applicants must complete all sections of the application and each of the six requirements of the checklist.

Evaluation:

In evaluating the applications, preferences will be given to those demonstrating need, desire and initiative. Applications will only be accepted until February 25, 2022. All applicants will be notified of the decision of the scholarship committee by April 25, 2022.

Application Submission:

Complete applications and supporting information must arrive by February 25, 2022. Our preference is that the materials be submitted in .pdf format via email (<u>theatreofdareobx@gmail.com</u>). One file would be nice, but multiple files are acceptable. You may also submit the application as requested by your high school's scholarship program protocol.



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Checklist

Completed scholarship applications must be submitted no later than February 25, 2022, preferably in .pdf format via email. You may also submit the application as requested by your high school's scholarship program protocol.

Applicants should submit the following (one .pdf document is preferable; multiple documents are acceptable):

Scholarship Application Form

A copy of your transcript(s) and latest report card, including transcripts for any college courses completed

A resume of experience and training in the performing arts to date

Two recommendation statements, speaking to your character, academic ability, and performance (or performance related) talents

An acceptance letter, if available, from the institution where you intend to study the performing arts

A statement of approximately 250 words stating why you are applying for the scholarship - we invite you to submit an additional account of how COVID-19 has affected your endeavors
